What are Recreational vehicles & Off road vehicles?



- *Scooters are now legal on local streets (new Aug 1, 2005)
SS 169.225
- Age 12 to 17 - Must have Helmets
- Under 15mph
- Right side of roadway & must walk across road for a left turn
- Still, illegal on sidewalks & parks. (Rec. vehicle ord. 8.66)

Electric Scooters



- Are now legal on local streets (new Aug 1, 2005) SS 169.225
- prohibited on sidewalks & Parks
- See City code 8.66 & S.S. 169.225

Power Boards or Dirt surfers



- Gas or electric powered
- 22 or 30 mph
- no light or safety features
- defined as Rec. vehicles and prohibited on roads and sidewalks & parks

Go Karts



- Gas powered
- No safety lighting or signals
- 5 hp motors
- Speeds to 25mph
- Def. As “Recreational vehicle” -city code
- illegal streets/
sidewalks & parks

Mini Bikes



- 50 to 80 cc engines
- Speeds up to 35mph
- Off road use only
- Prohibited – Rec. Vehicle.
- No Street, sidewalk or parks

Mopeds (Legal)

- Can be street legal
- up to 30 mph
- Can be licensed and drivers issued moped permits
- Have safety features
- Are NOT Rec. vehicles - have transportation aspect.
- Need to follow traffic laws.



Motorized bike



- Legal – not “Rec. vehicles
- Have pedals and can be self propelled
- Two tandem wheels
- Motor less that 50cc
- Max speed 30mph
- Ok on Street – as bikes
Not on sidewalk or parks.
- Lic. Or a permit needed.

Segways: Personal Assistive mobility Devices

*legal on sidewalks & Parks



** under some
circumstances
can be on the
streets. (Ss 169.212)

Mobility Scooter- Disability need
Legal –not recreational / like Segways



City ord. # 8.65 to 8.71

Recreational/ Off Road Vehicles

- Private property with permission
- No use on School property, parks, playgrounds
- No sidewalk use or pedestrian trail or walkway
- No street or Highway use unless licensed or are scooters* Aug 2005
- Review other prohibitions in 8.66
