

# Explanation of 2024 Budget Increases (\$2.1 million)

- \$1,447,305 Projected salary and benefits increases for cost-of-living adjustments, step increases, and an additional Public Safety Telecommunicator position (*Civilian Police and Fire Dispatcher*)
- \$648,929 Increase in Internal Charges
  - Primary drivers:
    - \$391K Fleet
    - \$182K IT
    - \$ 25K Police Equipment
- \$57,679 2.68% Increase in Materials, Supplies, and Services

## Challenges

- Replacing Police Officers due to upcoming retirements
  - Maintaining adequate number of officers to respond to calls is crucial
  - Focus on employee retention
  - · Pathways to Policing
  - Police Cadets
  - · Training programs
  - Ensuring that hiring for character, training for competence, and unwaveringly reinforcing the mission, vision, and core value
- Maintaining and replacing aging equipment





## Public Safety – State Aid \$3,899,210

- \$ 716,000 proposed for Fire Department
- \$ 375,000 proposed for Legal Department
- \$ 2,808,210 proposed for Police Department
- \$ 3,899,210 total

The details of a proposed plan for the \$2.8 million for Police spending of the Public State Aid \$ will be presented to the City Council later this year.
