Bloomington, MN - In early 2014, the City of Bloomington began work on updating the City's Alternative Transportation Plan (ATP). The ATP Update will:

- Include identification and prioritization of a core bicycle and pedestrian network throughout the City.
- Include new elements that focus on enhancement and maintenance of existing trail and sidewalk network, as well as way-finding.
- Acknowledge work done over the past six years and provide direction for future implementation and maintenance efforts.

This past summer residents provided input to identify gaps in the system and barriers to use through an online survey, stakeholder meetings and resident open houses. The draft plan document is now available for review at BloomingtonMN.gov, keywords "ATP Update."
