VEHICLE 1 WAS TRAVELING NORTH ON 24TH AVE S WHEN THE FRONT END STRUCK THE RIGHT SIDE OF VEHICLE 2. VEHICLE 2 WAS TRAVELING EAST ON LINDAU LN.

DRIVER 1 STATED SHE WAS TRAVELING NORTH ON 24TH AVE S WHEN SHE STRUCK VEHICLE 2. DRIVER 1 STATED SHE DID NOT KNOW WHAT COLOR THE LIGHT AT THE INTERSECTION WAS. DRIVER 1 DID NOT KNOW HOW FAST SHE WAS TRAVELING.

DRIVER 2 STATED SHE WAS TRAVELING EAST ON LINDAU LN AND HAD A GREEN LIGHT, WHEN SHE PROCEED TO GO THROUGH THE INTERSECTION VEHICLE 1 STRUCK HER. DRIVER 2 SAID SHE WAS TRAVELING 30 MPH.

WITNESS 1 STATED HE DID NOT KNOW WHAT COLOR THE LIGHT WAS AT THE INTERSECTION AT THE TIME OF THE CRASH, BUT HAS A CAMERA IN THE CAR THAT RECORDED THE ACCIDENT. DRIVER 1 WAS UNABLE TO PULL UP THE VIDEO WHEN THE REPORT WAS TAKEN.

WITNESS 2 STATED HE WAS BEHIND DRIVER 2 TRAVELING EAST ON LINDAU LN AND THAT DRIVER 2 HAD A GREEN LIGHT WHEN VEHICLE 1 HIT VEHICLE 2 AS DRIVER 2 WAS ATTEMPTING TO GO THROUGH THE INTERSECTION.

Unit 1 was traveling southbound on Portland Ave S and turning left onto eastbound American Blvd E. Unit 1 said that they had a green arrow when they made the turn and they were hit by unit 2.

Unit 2 said that she was northbound in the right lane of Portland Ave S and was continuing Northbound through the intersection. Unit 2 said that she was stopped and then had a green light when she entered the intersection and Unit 1 turned in front of her.

There was no 3rd party witness on scene. Unit 1 did not have a valid driver's license and was cited for no driver's license. Unit 1 was towed from the scene. Unit 2 was able to be driven a short distance to a repair shop.

When approaching the intersection at Portland Unit 2 came to a stop at the red traffic light. Unit 1 struck Unit 2 from behind. There was minor damage to Unit 1's front end and minor damage to Unit 2's rear end. Unit 2 was operable and no tow required. Unit 1 gave indications of impairment and provided a PBT of .267.

Crash involving 3 vehicles.

Crash occurred in left lane of east bound Old Shakopee Road at Washburn Avenue South. There was a vehicle (uninvolved in crash) that was in front of the crash and making a left / north turn onto Washburn which caused unit #3 and #2 to slow and stop for that vehicle making the turn. Just after it made the turn, Unit #1 rear-ended unit #2 who then rear-ended unit #3.

I spoke to the driver of unit #1 who was a lone occupant. She said that maybe her brakes were not working good but then said she had a phone call coming in and was trying to turn off Bluetooth (she was distracted).

I spoke to the driver / lone occupant of unit #2 who was grabbing towards his back and appeared in pain. He said that he was stopped for a turning vehicle and the other vehicle didn't even appear to slow striking his vehicle pushing him into the vehicle in front of him.

Allina was ordered for Unit #2 but he later self transported when another person arrived to help him.

Unit #3 was occupied 2 times. Again the driver said she was stopped waiting for the vehicle to turn and it did, and she started forward and was rear-ended. She had neck pain and said her passenger / daughter was not injured.

All vehicles were still drivable and not towed. Unit #1 had front end damage. Unit #2 had front and rear damage. Unit #3 had rear end damage.
