Crews are now installing fiber-optic cables for high-speed T-Mobile Fiber internet service in your community.

Construction in public rights-of-way or easements is scheduled according to municipal guidelines, **Monday through Friday.**

- Crews will work to minimize disruption to roads, sidewalks, and landscaping.
- · Please be aware of parking restrictions during construction.
- Minimal impact is expected on holidays, weekends, and evenings.
- Crews will restore the work area when installation is complete.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is Intrepid Fiber?

Intrepid Fiber is a developer who privately funds, builds, and operates fiber-optic networks.

How is the project being built?

Construction includes attaching cable aerially to existing utility poles or underground within a conduit that is connected to an above ground cabinet. Cabinets contain important equipment required for deployment of the fiber network.

How long will construction last?

Construction begins with a survey and submittal for required permits. Residents receive a notification via door hanger prior to construction beginning. Where applicable, existing utilities will locate their facilities prior to construction. The physical construction process is quick and efficient and should take several days.

How will the area be restored?

Once construction is complete, Intrepid Fiber crews will restore to previous conditions.

Where is Intrepid Fiber burying the fiber cable?

Construction permits, which are issued by a state or local government, give Intrepid Fiber the right to build the network in public rights-of-ways and easements near the road in a particular jurisdiction. Where applicable, Intrepid Fiber has to separately secure the rights to construct on private property, such as in a multifamily apartment building, in a gated community, or across a private road.

When will fiber-optic service be available for my home?

Once the network is complete, it will be available to your neighborhood. If you live in a private development or multifamily unit, more permissions may be required before you can get fiber-optic service. Contact your property manager, landlord, or housing association if you're interested in fiber-optic service in these locations.

What internet speeds will be available?

Your area will have service of 500 Mbps, 1 Gig (1000 Mbps), and 2 Gig (2000 Mbps) upload and download speeds. Join the T-Mobile Fiber waitlist today at **T-MobileFiber.com**.
