According to dispatch the reporting party was Pat Conrad with Bloomington Utilities (952-563-4911) reporting the incident involved a City of Bloomington dump truck and a private vehicle and there were no injuries.

As I got into the area and near the railroad tracks east of Hampshire Avenue in the right lane of westbound traffic there was a large amount of dirt, rocks and gravel from the railroad tracks to the intersection of Hampshire and Old Shakopee Road where the vehicles pulled off north of the intersection.

UNIT 2: City of Bloomington Vehicle - MN Plate 948241 a 2015, International dump truck carrying a load of dirt and rock was traveling westbound on Old Shakopee Road. Approximately 600 ft prior to the intersection at Hampshire Avenue the vehicle drove over the railroad tracks at which time the tailgate somehow opened releasing the load of rock and dirt onto the road and vehicle UNIT 1 traveling westbound behind the dump truck. Unit 2 was being driven by City of Bloomington Worker, Adam Lingle, who reported he was unaware of how the tailgate opened other than the bumps of the railroad causing it to occur. Picture of the rear of the dump truck showed the two safety chains were not connected at the rear of the tailgate.

UNIT 1: 2015, Lexus, MN Plate KDH496 driven by the son of the RO, Nolan Weisz, reported he was driving behind the dump truck when the load of dirt and rock began falling onto the vehicle. Nolan stated he was wearing his seatbelt, no airbags deployed, no injuries and that the windshield of the vehicle was previously cracked from the base of the window through the windshield. Nolan provided insurance for his vehicle through American Family (0710416305) and was given a file number for the incident. The damage to vehicle if any was not visible due to the dirt on the windshield and hood of vehicle. It appears any possible damage would be on the front of the vehicle or the undercarriage of the vehicle but was not visible to this officer due to the dirt/debris from the dump truck.

Pictures were uploaded. Both drivers were clear with valid DLs and provided proof of insurance.

City vehicles including a large skid loader and street sweeper arrived to clear the roadway from the large amount of debris the dump truck had dropped.

Unit 1 had moderate damage to the driver side bumper and side panel. Unit 2, directly ahead of Unit 1, had been scratched from the passenger side front wheel well and side panel to the rear wheel well.

I spoke to the driver of Unit 1 first, the driver had indicated that he was in lane 2 of the turning lane onto American Blvd from Northbound Lyndale Ave S. Unit 1 attempted to change lanes from lane 2 to lane 1. Unit 2 was in lane 1, when unit 1 switched lanes and collided with Unit 2. Driver of unit 1 doesn't claim any responsibility or fault for the accident.

Unit 1 was an Uber driver. I made contact with the passenger of Unit 1, the passenger claims that Unit 1 was rushing and changed lanes from 2 to 1. The passenger also claims that Unit 1 had made contact with Unit 2.

I spoke to the driver of Unit 2. The driver of Unit 2 stated she was in lane 1 turning Westbound on American from Northbound Lyndale S. The driver started to go when the light had turned green, when Unit 2 applied the gas Unit 1 hit the vehicle from the passenger side front wheel well, all the way to the back of the passenger rear wheel well.

Neither drivers claimed responsibility or fault for the accident. It should be noted that I contacted the passenger of Unit 1 after the accident, at a later time.

Unit 1 stopped at red light southbound 12th Av S & American Blvd E. After stopping, Unit 1 started to turn westbound onto American Blvd from correct outside lane. As this was happening, Unit 2 and Witness 1 both on bikes started to cross American Blvd, southbound on 12th Av. Just as they entered the intersection, Unit 1's front bumper struck Unit 2's front wheel at idle speed causing Unit 2 to fall off bike.
