ORDINANCE NO. 2024-48

AN ORDINANCE ADDING A REQUIREMENT FOR TWO-FOOT CLEAR ZONES ADJACENT TO PUBLIC SIDEWALKS AS DETERMINED BY THE CITY ENGINEER, THEREBY AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE CITY CODE.

The City Council of the City of Bloomington, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. That Chapter 21 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting those words that are contained in brackets and [stricken through] and adding those words that are underlined, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 21: ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT

ARTICLE III: DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS **DIVISION A: GENERAL STANDARDS**

21.301.04 SIDEWALKS.

(d) Design standards. Except for private sidewalks on single- and two-family residential sites, sidewalks must conform to the following design standards.

(10) Clear zones for public sidewalks. Along the edges of public sidewalks, twofoot clear zones must be provided as determined by the City Engineer or designee for user safety and maintenance purposes.

Maintenance. Sidewalks must be maintained according to the following standards. (e)

(4) Clear zones. Clear zones required in subsection (d)(10) above must be maintained as determined by the City Engineer or designee on an ongoing basis.
