Officers arrived on scene with Allina paramedics and Bloomington Fire Department. Two vehicles were seen in the intersection. Unit #1 was parked in the Eastbound lane on 82nd Street on the south side, and Unit #2 was half way in the intersection of 82nd Street and Penn Ave S facing west. Unit #2 had obvious severe damage to the driver and passenger door, along with all of the airbags deployed. Unit #1 had damage to the front driver corner disabling the headlight. Unit #1 was drivable, Unit #2 was not and towed from the scene by Chief's Towing.

Driver of Unit #2 stated to have shoulder pain in the left shoulder from the initial impact from Unit #1. Passenger #1 from Unit #2 was indicating pain in her right wrist. Both parties were escorted into the ambulance. Driver of Unit #1 did not claim any injuries on scene and refused to give a statement of what occurred. Driver of Unit #2 stated to be driving Northbound on Penn Ave S towards American Blvd. and Unit #1 was traveling Southbound on Penn Ave S. Unit #2 stated that they were crossing through the T-intersection of 82nd Street and Penn Ave S when Unit #1 did not stop at the flashing yellow arrow to turn Eastbound and ultimately t-boned them. Due to the impact, Unit #2 spun ninety degrees ending facing West in the intersection. At the time of the initial impact, is when Passenger #1 sustained a broken wrist.

Driver of Unit #1 was on the phone with Aunt who claimed to be an attorney and advised not to speak to police until she arrived on scene, which was approximately thirty minutes. Driver of Unit #1 checked on Unit #2 and stated occupants yelled at him. Driver of Unit #1 did not want to give any further statement, declined medical attention, and left the scene in the vehicle.

Witness #1 stated to have observed the crash and stated all he could remember was the driver of Unit #1 hit Unit #2. Witness #1 could not recall direction of travel of either vehicle.

Allina transported Passenger #1 to FVSD for a broken wrist (run #252605774). Driver of Unit #2 was transported to the hospital by other means from the scene.

Both drivers were provided case number for the accident.

Dispatch advised that two vehicles were involved, and the injuries were unknown.

Upon arrival, I spoke with a witness who identified himself as Gerald Hughes. Gerald said he and the Toyota Camry were traveling northbound Normandale, had green lights, and the Chevrolet SUV drove in front of them trying to turn onto eastbound 98th Street when it impacted the Camry.

I observed a Toyota Camry bearing MN #PST330 with moderate front-end damage, front airbags deployed, and a shattered front windshield. I identified the driver and solo occupant as KRAINESS, JULIETTE NICOLE. Nicole denied having injuries other than an irritated eye, possibly from the smoke of the airbag. She said she was traveling northbound on Normandale, going approximately 45mph, and attempted to drive through the green light and was hit by another vehicle.

Vehicle 2, a Chevrolet SUV bearing Minnesota #JPP873, was driven by Ma Santos. A driver's license for the Republic of the Philippines identified her. She told Officer Burt that she was driving southbound Normandale when she had a yellow light and was turning left to go eastbound on 98th Street. She said she knew she had to yield to oncoming traffic but could not make it though the intersection and impacted the other car. A passenger was also identified, and both denied needing medical attention. Airbags were deployed inside the Chevrolet SUV.

Chief's towing towed both vehicles due to disabling damage. Officer Burt took digital photographs of the scene and later uploaded them to EVIDENCE.COM via AXON.
