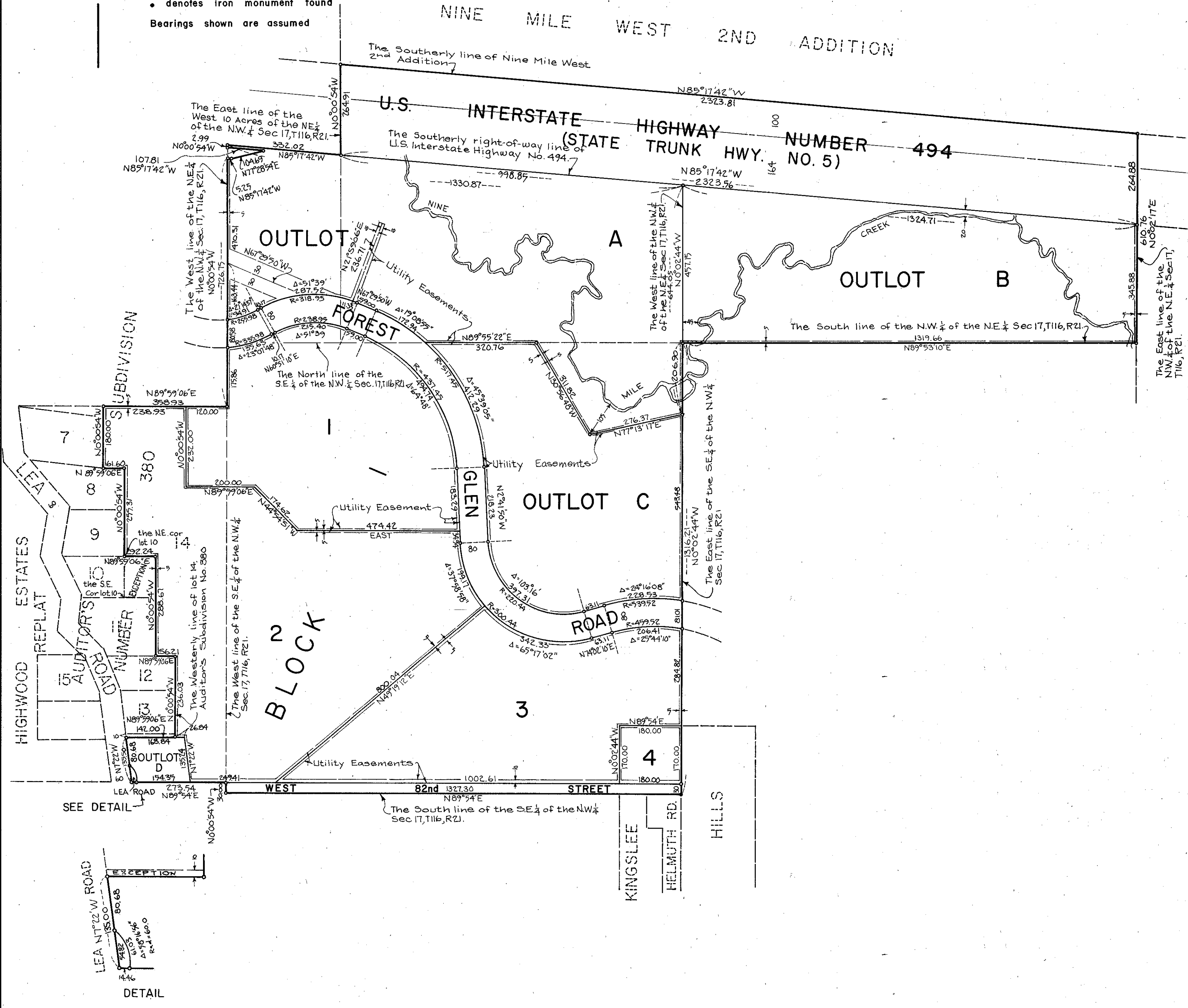


HIGHWOOD ESTATES SECOND ADDITION

Know all men by these presents; That The Normandale Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the Laws of the State of Minnesota, owner and proprietor, of the following described property situated in the County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, to wit:

Lot 14, except that part thereof described as beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 13; thence East to the Southeast corner of Lot 13; thence South along the extension of the East line of Lot 13 a distance of 10 feet; thence West, parallel to the South line of Lot 13, to the Westerly line of Lot 14; thence Northerly to the point of beginning; also except that part of Lot 14 described as beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 10; thence South to the Southeast corner of Lot 10; thence East to the Northeast corner of Lot 11; thence North along the extension of the East line of Lot 11 to its intersection with the extension East of the North line of Lot 10; thence West to the point of beginning; all in AUDITOR'S SUBDIVISION NUMBER 380, HENNEPIN COUNTY, Minnesota

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter lying South of the Southerly line of NINE MILE WEST 2ND ADDITION all in Section 17, Township 116, Range 21.

That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter lying East of the West 10 acres thereof and lying South of the Southerly line of NINE MILE WEST 2ND ADDITION all in Section 17, Township 116, Range 21.
