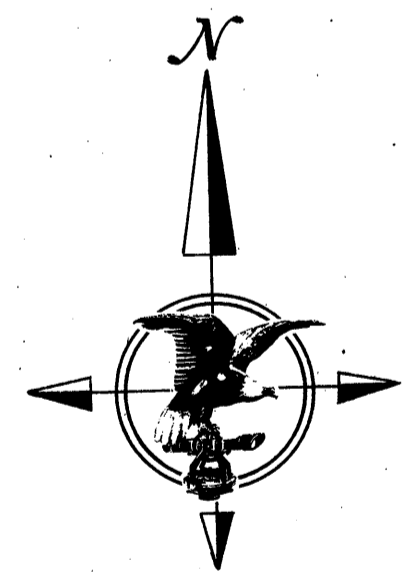
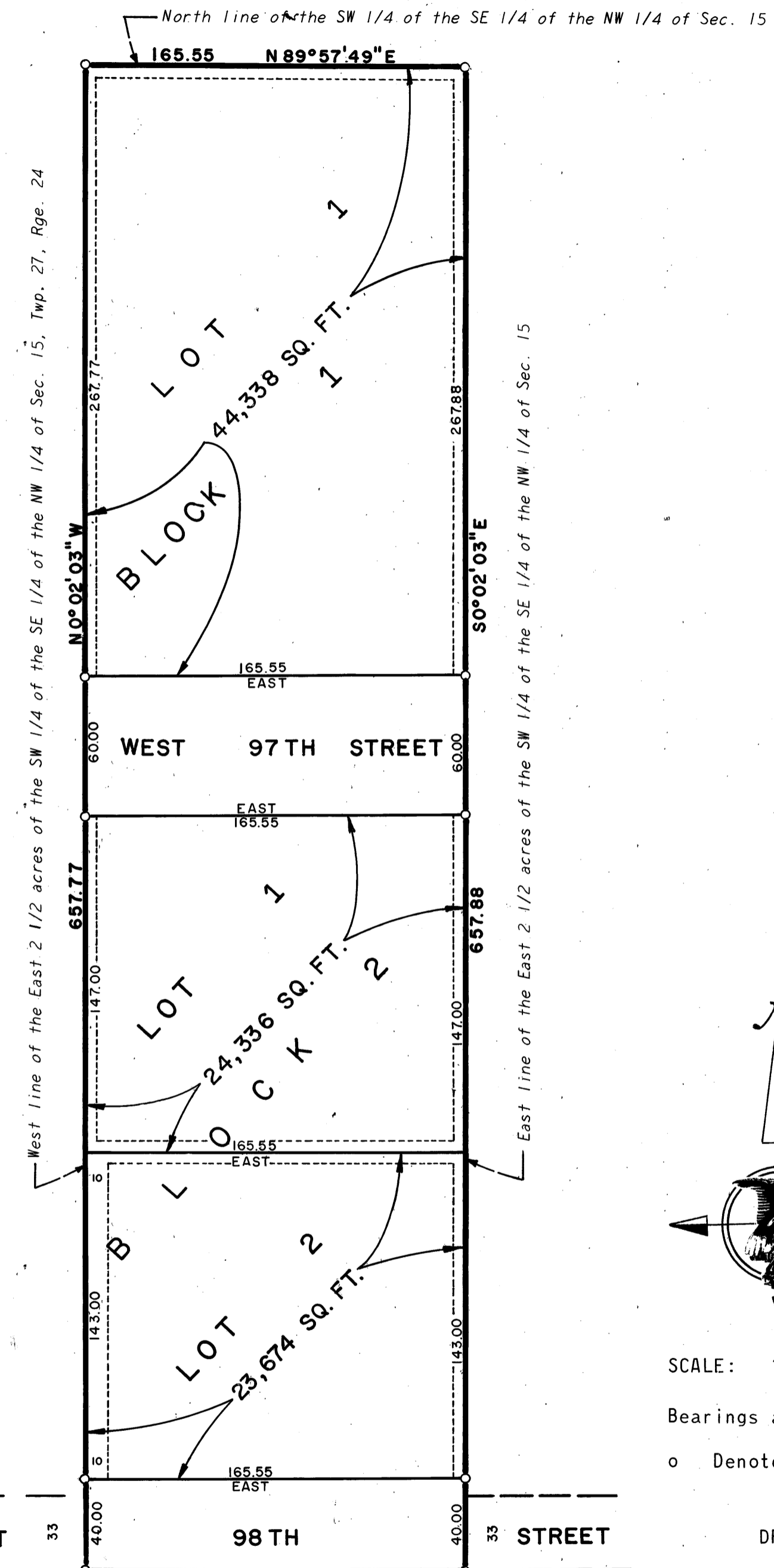
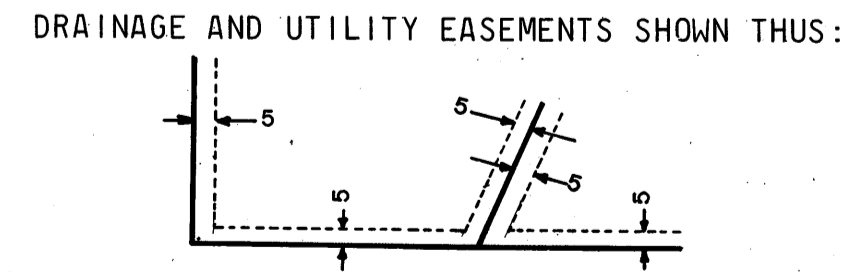


JANSKI 1ST ADDITION
