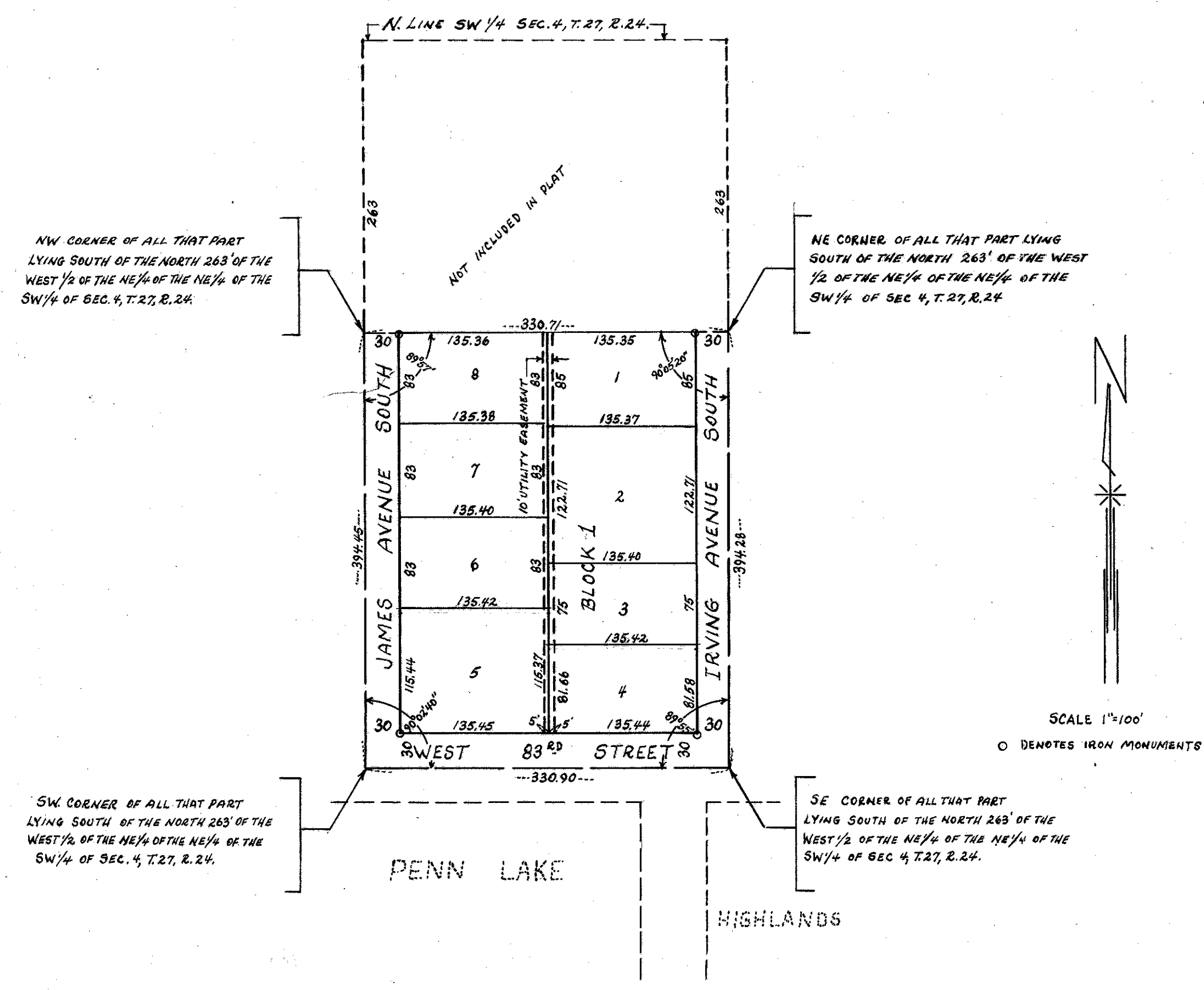


LUETH ADDITION
